



## SWAMP HOPSCOTCH

This is a game that involves a lot of activity and even more imagination. This being "Swamp" Hopscotch, players should imagine themselves in a swamp setting, somewhere wet, hot and humid. The swamp area is that in the middle of the court and the lines separating the squares are swampy waters, which can be infested with frogs, leeches and even crocodiles! The many squares numbered from 1 to 14 are the dry patches of land on which players are supposed to remain upon in order to maneuver through the swamp!

The game begins with players starting in square 1 and each player must hop on one foot through the numbers until they reach 14. If they can complete this successfully, players are then to jump backwards on one foot through the numbers until they reach 1.

However, as tired as players may be, this is not the end of the game! Players must now jump all the way back to the 14 square but this time they must only jump on odd numbers, until the third time, when they must jump on only the even numbers. This game can be made more difficult by changing up the sequence of numbers that must be hopped on! Make sure not to jump on those lines or fall into the swamp, or else you might be out of the game!
